

Healthcare Commission Community Mental Health Survey 2007

Gloucestershire Partnership NHS Trust took part in the Healthcare Commission's Community Mental Health Survey between January and March 2007.

A questionnaire reflecting the priorities of Service Users across 8 areas of care was sent to a random 850 people subject to the Care Programme Approach who had received a service in the previous 3 months. For the second year questionnaires were sent to service users over the age of 65 years but the benchmark reports prepared by the Healthcare commission have been calculated using only respondents aged 65 years and under to enable comparability with previous surveys .

202 questionnaires were therefore evaluated and the findings compare the Partnership Trust with the other 68 Trusts who participated.

These comparisons can be seen on this website together with a paper recently presented to the Trust's Practice Standards Committee. There is also an update to the action plan which addressed the findings of the 2006 Survey together with an action plan to address the areas identified by 2007 Survey as needing improvement.
