# Recognising Outstanding Service and Contribution Awards ROSCAs



Gloucestershire Partnership NHS Foundation Trust is holding its first ever staff awards ceremony in November 2007. - Somebody from hotel services who went the extra mile to make sure you were comfortable?

## You can nominate individuals or teams in the following categories:-

1. **The service users and carers choice** (Awarded to an individual) This award will be given to the individual who has made an outstanding contribution. This can be in any area, e.g. clinical care, service user involvement, carer involvement, administrative, support services). The choice is yours. Nominations for this award are invited from service users or carers who have contact with Gloucestershire Partnership NHS Foundation Trust.
2. **Clinical Team of the Year Award** (Awarded to a Team) This award will be given to a clinical team who have worked together to get the job done really really well for the benefit of service users and carers.
3. **Non-Clinical Team of the Year Award** (Awarded to a team) This award will be given to a non-clinical team – perhaps administrative, finance, IT, or support staff.

Nominations for these awards are invited from service users or carers who have contact with Gloucestershire Partnership NHS Foundation Trust.

## Closing date

Nomination forms need to be submitted by the closing date of Wednesday, 31 October 2007. No entry will be accepted after this date.
