

I want to nominate somebody – what are the categories?

The ROSCAs will recognise excellence in nine broad categories:

- 1. The Unsung Hero Award** (Individual). Awarded to a volunteer who is registered with the Trust and has shown dedication above and beyond the call of duty
- 2. CEO Award for Innovation** (Individual or Team). An individual or a team who are “switched” on to new developments and innovative ways of working to improve life for service users or staff.
- 3. The carer and service user involvement award** (Individual or team) An award that recognises a genuine commitment to putting the needs of service users and carers at the heart of what we do.
- 4. The service users and carers choice** (Individual). An award to an individual who, from the service user’s or carer’s point of view, has made an outstanding contribution in any area.
- 5. Clinical Team of the Year Award** (Team). An award that recognises the efforts of a clinical team who have worked together to get the job done really really well.
- 6. Non-Clinical Team of the Year Award** (Team). An award that recognises the effort of a non-clinical team who have worked together to get the job done really really well.
- 7. Innovative Contribution to Work Life Balance Award** (Individual or team). Awarded to the individual or team who have introduced creative ways to preserve the work life balance that brings benefits to all.
- 8. Best Supporting Colleague Award** (Individual). Awarded to an individual who is exceptional, one who helps his/her colleagues and is tireless in their efforts.
- 9. Best Supporting Manager Award** (Individual). Awarded to the manager whose support has been exceptional and made a real difference to your working life.

The Panel

A panel of judges will analyse the nominations and will shortlist nominees in each category. Each winning team/individual will receive a framed certificate and a photograph of them receiving the award. All shortlisted nominees will be invited to the awards ceremony on the evening of 28 November at Cheltenham Racecourse.

Closing date

Nomination forms need to be submitted by the closing date of Wednesday 31st October 2007. No entry will be accepted after this date.

Rules

Nominations can be made by current employees of Gloucestershire Partnership NHS Foundation Trust for all categories except for category 4 which is open to service users and carers only.

Nominees must be current employees of Gloucestershire Partnership NHS Foundation Trust or an active volunteer registered with the Trust at the time of nominations for the awards closing.

There is no limit on the number of nominations that can be made. However, neither individuals nor teams are eligible to nominate themselves or members of their family.

The closing date of 31 October 2007 for receipt of nominations is final.

The decisions of the judging panels will be final and no correspondence will be entered into regarding the decisions.
